May be possible for some areas to go back to public ownership and they remain open to discussions.	ALL

5	12/6/18	Nan McNab	Shed in Fenced Wetlands/New Drainage Works Advice that there is a shed inside the fenced wetland area on Lot 3. "Lane" through to Lot 3 is still being used and fenced wetlands have had horses and people on motor bikes at times. Nan suggested that Council should inspect the area and fencing. Drainage works have been undertaken on Lot 3.	ALL

AIDA invited to attend an "Ideation Workshop" for this project and the Wye River Bridge to discuss any lighting deficiencies and low key lighting alternatives. 9	20/6/18	Alex MacDonald GORCC	Vegetation Screens at Aireys Inlet GORCC applied to DELWP to install 3 vegetation screens where vegetation had been illegally damaged or removed along Eagle Rock Parade. Information signage will be attached to the screens and they will remain in place until the vegetation regenerates. Adjacent residents have been notified (Alice Road & Kingsley Drive).	ALL
10	16/6/18	Alison Witcombe	Carpark at Top Shops – Spaces Outside Post Office and Pharmacy Advice that following heavy rain these spaces either fill or partly fill with water. Difficult for drivers parked outside the Pharmacy to avoid the puddle of water. Danger of injury for the elderly, handicapped and children. The Pharmacist has complained to the SCS. Channel recently dug but doesn't work. Requested that AIDA approach Council to provide a solution to the problem as individual approaches have failed.	ALL
11	21/6/18	Brendan Walsh Surf Coast Shire	2 Fraser Drive – Community Advisory Panel Advice that Council had been working with the submitter regarding the project to arrive at an acceptable alternative. One partner of the submitter has withdrawn and the other partner is unable to deliver the project objectives. Project to be put on hold and consider alternatives to be presented to the Council and community at the start of 2019. Happy to receive any alternative AIDA may have.	ALL
