7	1/8/19	Nick Helliwell Surf Coast Shire	70 & 74 Bimbadeen Drive, Fairhaven Submitted objection to the proposed development at 70 Bimbadeen Drive, Fairhaven: - Property is 4 storeys high with roof deck and jacuzzin on 4 th story – 13.26 meters above natural ground level (above the 7.5 requirement). Small footprint of the proposal is not a significant reason for increasing the footprint of the building. Should decrease height as the land is large enough. - Proposal is dominant on the landscape – protrudes above the tree canopy when view from across the creek. - Lack of clarity regarding trenching for power and sewerage. Questioned what vegetation would be removed if directional drilling proves to be too expensive.
