Council will review the current car park arrangements.	ALL

9	24/8/18	Sophie Stickland Surf Coast Shire	6 Sutherland Court & 34 Boyd Avenue, Moggs Creek Advised that AIDA had raised a valid point regarding the loss of 112 square metres of land from the recreation reserves in Moggs Creek. The Council resolution to sell the land was made at a confidential meeting and information discussed must remain confidential. She assured "that all revenue received from acquisitions of this nature would be held in Council's Open Space cash reserves and therefore used in accordance with the principles outlined in your letter". Will ensure that all stakeholders are informed and updated, organise, attend site inspections and arrange meetings with specialists and outside agencies as required.	ALL

Advised that Council has no plan to re-route all main traffic inland away from Anglesea; it was not a "sneaky meeting"; it was well promoted to AIDA members and the wider community; and that feedback from the meeting would assist Council's decision about reopening the road.
2	4/8/18	Keith Baillie Libby Coker Margot Smith Anne Howard Surf Coast Shire	Coalmine Road Meeting Thanks for attending the meeting which highlighted the complexities and issues around opening the road.
3	5/8/18	Libby Coker Surf Coast Shire	Coalmine Road Meeting Look forward to continuing to work with LC while Council reaches a decision about opening the road.
4	6/8/18	Planning Department Surf Coast Shire	Planning Application – 6 Southerland Court & 34 Boyd Avenue, Moggs Creek Concerned regarding loss of 112sqm of land from recreation reserves in Moggs Creek and what will happen with the amount paid by the owner "to formalise the purchase of 112 sqm from the Surf Coast Shire". Land should either be added to a reserve in Moggs Creek or associated funds from the land sale be invested in recreation reserves in Moggs Creek.

Have been advised that there are also new sheds for horse shelters (not confirmed) and horses continue to be in the fenced areas. Asked about progress on the various compliance issues, particularly removing the horses from the protected ephemeral wetlands.
8	16/8/18	As Above	As Above Thanks for response. Community concern about how churned up the land is and that horses remain in the fenced wetlands. Asked if there was a time frame for removing the horses. Assumption is that the Woods have been going the works. Advised that Nan McNab would be able to help with his questions about who noticed the works.

9	27/8/18	Andrew Hewitt CC: Bill Cathcart Nick Helliwell Libby Coker Margot Smith Surf Coast Shire	Painkalac Valley Questioned if the recent works in the valley had been inspected and requested advice on: - if permits are/were required for recent fencing - if there had been applications for horse shelters - progress on enforcement of the CMP - progress on stopping horses grazing the fenced ephemeral wetlands and to stop vehicles accessing the areas - if the drainage works and related soil disturbance over Lot 3 complies with the SCS Planning Scheme and CMP - Shire plans to prevent further damage in the valley and seek rectification for damage done
